The FAO staff is available to offer assistance completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and answer questions regarding financial aid programs such as grants, work-study, and scholarships. The U.S. Department of Education offers federal student aid programs. Red Lake Nation College offers three federal financial aid programs: 1) Federal Pell Grant, 2) Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant (FSEOG), and 3) Federal Work-Study (FWS).

Students are urged to apply as soon as possible after January 1 every year for the following academic year. Complete, accurate, and timely submission of all information requested on the application form will maximize a student's opportunity for obtaining adequate financial assistance.
