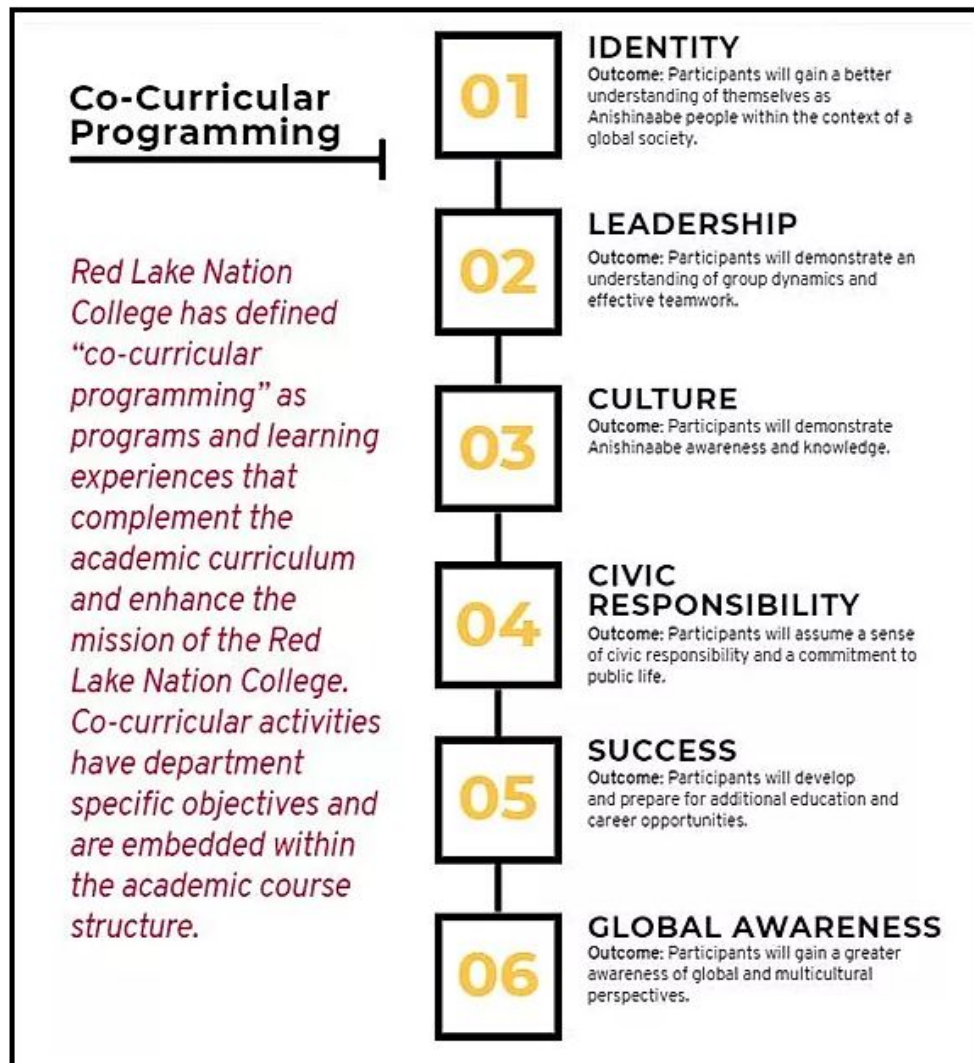




Co-Curricular Assessment
